

WHAT: Water & Sewer Maintenance

WHEN: Within 1-14 Days of May 22, 2019

WHERE: 400 Block McKercher Drive

The City performs regular maintenance on the drinking water, sanitary sewer and storm water systems year-round. Occasionally, one of these systems requires repair or rehabilitation to provide continuous and safe water and wastewater service for residents. The **drinking water** system located on your block has been scheduled for this maintenance.

During this project

- Service lines will be located and marked on the street with bright paint one to five days before work is commenced. The work schedule will not be confirmed until the night before work begins.
- Once work begins, City of Saskatoon crews will dig through the road to uncover the pipes and complete the work. An average repair will be completed in six to eight hours, weather permitting.
- Water will be restored when the work is completed, typically by 3 p.m. If water is expected to be shut off longer than eight hours, an emergency water supply trailer is delivered.

How you can help

- Stay clear of the work zone for your safety and the safety of workers.
- Remove vehicles from the area where the paint markings appear. Remaining vehicles may be relocated to a nearby street.
- Watch for the yellow Drinking Water Advisory notice at your front door and follow instructions provided.

Common questions



Will black, blue, or green cart collections be affected as a result of this work?

Residents directly adjacent to the work area are required to leave their carts outside of the work area prior to 7am on the day of collection. The contractor will coordinate the pickup of your cart.



Will there be traffic and street/driveway access restrictions?

There will be restrictions adjacent to the work area while this maintenance takes place. Signs will be posted after 6 AM on the day of work and traffic will be detoured as required.



Will parking be affected?

For homes and businesses adjacent to the work area, access to on street parking will be restricted. For residents with mobility requirements please contact us.



Will water and sewer service be affected?

If your water services are turned off, households/businesses will experience disruptions to their water services followed by the issuance of a yellow Drinking Water Advisory, advising residents to boil their water prior to ingesting until laboratory results confirm the water is safe to drink.



Will bus routes change?

Bus routes within the construction area may be affected. Please watch for signs posted for alternate bus stops or use the mobile app called 'Transit' for real-time bus information.
